Graduate Council Resolution in Support of Revising the Doctoral GPA Admission Requirements

Whereas, the GPA requirement for remaining in good standing in a doctoral degree program at SIU was previously revised to be a minimum GPA of 3.00.

Whereas, there are three paths to admission into a doctoral degree program at SIU:

- 1. "Normal" (requiring completion of a master's degree or equivalent);
- 2. Direct Entry (requiring completion of a bachelor's degree only);
- 3. Accelerated Entry, both for SIU and for Non-SIU Graduate students (requiring completion of at least one semester in a master's program).

Whereas, the GPA requirements for admission via all of these paths remains as "at least 3.25."

Whereas, this means that the requirements to enter a doctoral program are more stringent than to remain in it.

Whereas, the 3.25 GPA requirements limit the flexibility of doctoral programs to admit applicants that they may feel are qualified.

Whereas, grading practices can vary widely among US and especially international institutions of higher education.

Whereas, grading scales from international institutions are subject to interpretation when being translated to SIU's grading scale.

Whereas, doctoral programs are requesting the Dean of the Graduate School to make GPA admission exceptions, many for students with a GPA between 3.0 and 3.25.

Whereas, programs remain free to impose higher GPA standards than the Graduate School minimum requirements.

Whereas, programs remain free to select the students to admit from among those that meet their program's and the Graduate School's minimum requirements.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Graduate Council approves revising the GPA requirements for admission to doctoral programs at SIU, via *all* admission paths, to be "at least 3.00."
