Overview of Morris Library's Services for Distance Education and Off-campus Students, Staff, and Faculty

Reference/Information Services

Students, faculty, and staff may receive reference assistance from the staff at Morris Library.

- They may contact Mary Taylor, the Medical and Distance Learning Librarian, directly via email (mtaylor@lib.siu.edu) or by phone (866-241-1567, ask for Mary Taylor). Her direct line is 618-453-5492. Her Fax number is 618-453-3010.
- They may ask for help from the staff at the Library's Information Desk whenever the library is open, using the Library's toll-free (in the U.S.) number (866-241-1567).
- They may use the Library's online instant messaging reference service, Morris Messenger. This service is available 12 p.m. 4 p.m. (CST), Monday-Friday, and 6 p.m. 9 p.m. (CST), Monday-Wednesday, except during Southern Illinois University Carbondale's campus break periods. Morris Messenger may be accessed from the Morris Library home page (Click on the link that says "Ask Anything!")
- They may use the Library's general email reference service, Ask Morris. Members of the Library's staff will usually respond within 1-2 business days Monday-Friday. Ask Morris may be accessed via the Ask Anything link on Morris Library's home page.

Research Resources

Many of Morris Library subscription databases, electronic journals, and books are available outside of the library via Morris Library's Web site.

The Library's Web site (http://www.lib.siu.edu) has sections for locating information via various formats, including books ("Books"), article citations ("Databases / Find Articles"), electronic journals ("eJournal Finder"), government information (see the "Government Information" link on the "Databases / Find Articles" page), and reference tools such as dictionaries (see the "Reference" link on the "Databases / Find Articles" page). Patrons should contact Mary Taylor for assistance, or they may want to use the following online resources:

- **Find it Morris**: This tool creates direct links from a database citation to the full text of the article if available through Morris Library.

Obtaining Library Materials

Document delivery services are available for students, faculty, and staff who live at least an hour away from campus and do not work or have classes on campus. We will loan items or send a copy of an article if it is available at Morris or obtain materials via interlibrary if we do not have them at Morris Library.

In general, Morris Library ships books and photocopies via 2-day courier service to all addresses in the United States. We also will send items overseas. See the "Get Materials" page for more details (http://www.lib.siu.edu/departments/distance/getmaterials). If the item is at Morris Library, it may take 4-5 days from the date of receiving the request until you receive the materials (UPS doesn't deliver on weekends).

Morris Library does not charge for shipping materials or for making photocopies or obtaining items via interlibrary loan. There is no limit to the number of requests patrons may make. Patrons are responsible for returning any items loaned to them to Morris Library, including paying the postage. They may keep photocopies.

If patrons need material from Morris Library reference books or other materials that may not be checked out, they should contact Mary Taylor (mtaylor@lib.siu.edu).

Instructors may reserve videos for instruction for their classes by contacting the Reserves Department at Morris Library. Videos will be sent at no charge.
