Whereas the School of Medicine is proposing the elimination of the post-baccalaureate certificate in Histotechnology; and


Whereas enrollment in the program was suspended in 2015 after the retirement of the program's primary faculty member and unsuccessful attempts to recruit a qualified replacement; and

Whereas throughout its history the program enrolled approximately seven students total and had two total students complete the program, and only two students have even shown interest in the past three years;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Graduate Council approves the RME for the elimination of the post-baccalaureate certificate program in Histology in the School of Medicine.


