- Graduate Council Resolution in support of Renaming the Master of Arts Degree in Applied Linguistics
- Graduate Council Resolution in support of the Proposed Elimination of the Master of Laws Degree in the School of Law
- Graduate Council Resolution in support of the Proposed Elimination of the Master of Legal Studies Degree in the School of Law
- Graduate Council Resolution in support of the Addition of an accelerated MA degree in Linguistics in the College of Liberal Arts
- Graduate Council Resolution in support of the Proposed Elimination of MBA concentrations in Change Management, Management of Information Systems, and International Business in the College of Business
